

Course Description

This half day program is designed for Family Medicine Physicians to better distinguish among proven approaches used in practice to help patients safely lose weight, including pharmacologic treatment, diets, counseling and bariatric surgery. Specific emphasis will be put on distinguishing among various types of weight loss strategies in order to individualize recommendations for patient populations. Discussion will also cover techniques for effectively enabling the patient to utilize the weight loss strategy to maintain long-term weight loss

- Go one block uphill to Sir William Osler Drive, turn right.

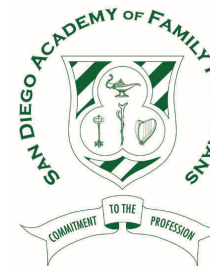
DO NOT purchase a permit from one of the parking kiosks, **PARKING IS FREE ON SATURDAYS IN LOT #P604.**
