



## **EDWIN REITHMAYER, M.D. Memorial Scholarship Award Information and Application**

The San Diego Academy of Family Physicians annually presents a memorial scholarship award to a medical student from the University of California, San Diego School of Medicine. The Edwin Reithmayer, M.D. Memorial Scholarship Award is presented to a fourth year medical student actively pursuing a Family Practice Residency who exemplifies "Excellence in Undergraduate Family Medicine".

This scholarship is awarded on a competitive basis. The recipient will receive a memorial plaque, complimentary dinner for two at the San Diego Academy of Family Physicians' Installation Dinner, and a check for \$1,000.00, to be awarded at the dinner. Recognition of the award is also provided at the annual UCSD Medical Student Awards Lunch traditionally held in June of each year. The application process for the 2020 Reithmayer Scholarship award requires submission of:

- The enclosed scholarship application form
- A current curriculum vitae
- An essay describing your interest in family medicine, long term career goals, and why you are deserving of this scholarship
- Copy of UCSD School of Medicine Transcript
- Signed letter of recommendation on letterhead from UCSD Family Medicine Predoctoral Director and a signed letter of recommendation from one other UCSD Faculty member on letterhead.

Personal Interview: January 15<sup>th</sup>, 2020 scheduled between the hours of 4:00 to 6:30pm on the UCSD campus. (**Attendance is required**)

Selection of Award Recipient: Notification via e-mail by January 19<sup>th</sup>, 2020.

Formal Award Presentation: The San Diego Academy of Family Physicians' Annual Installation Dinner, February 7<sup>th</sup>, 2020. (**Attendance is required**)
